Riffel's 2017 Binger Riesling Trocken Quarzit displays a clear, intense, elegant and refreshing flinty bouquet with ripe fruit and lemon aromas. Round and smooth on the well-textured and elegant palate, this full-bodied dry Riesling reveals nice grapefruit bitterness and quartzite raciness and piquancy on the strong finish. The wine indicates 13% alcohol and doesn't hide its quite elegant power. Drink Date 2019 – 2026

2017 Binger Silvaner Quarzit trocken

The 2017 Binger Silvaner Trocken Quarzit displays an intense and still yeasty, somewhat sweetish bouquet of ripe white fruits intermingled with tangy nutty aromas. Round and creamy on the palate, this is a charming Sylvaner with an all-too-smooth and charming but also full-bodied, slightly bitter and slightly saturating finish. The wine is well made yet lacks some finesse and kicking freshness on the finish. Drink Date 2020 – 2027
