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2018 Riesling Rheinhessen Scharlachberg Auslese

Score: 95 Points

Attractive, reductive notes of smoke and flint meet with steel-barrel and freshly peeled, pithy lemons. The fruit is so lively and the acidity sings out long amidst the medium sweetness, helping to triangulate the multitude of mineral and citrus flavors. Superb phenolic depth and structure. Drink now or hold.

2018 Riesling Rheinhessen Scharlachberg trocken

Score: 94 Points

There's a unique trait of eucalyptus and tea tree oil here, as well as persimmons and quince. Lots of loquat and mirabelle plums punctuate the palate, which is medium-to-full in body with an oily texture, but loads of filigree acidity. Drink now or hold.

2018 Riesling Rheinhessen Scharlachberg Kabinett

Score: 93 Points

Light biscuit and croissant aromas overlap with the driving lemon and orange-blossom character. This is only off-dry, but the sweetness is well integrated into the racy acidity. Drink now.

2018 Riesling Rheinhessen Binger Quarzit trocken

Score: 92 Points

An understated riesling with lots of stoney nuances that punctuate an otherwise citrus-laden nose of lemons and limes. The medium-bodied palate has taut acidity, but enough of an oily counterpoint. Drink now.

2018 Riesling Rheinhessen Kirchberg trocken

Score: 91 Points

Fresh lemons and green apples, as well as guava peel. Quite soft and supple on the palate with a fleshy core of stone fruit and moderate acidity. Drink now.

2017 Chardonnay Rheinhessen Réserve Trocken

Score: 91 Points

Plenty of creme caramel, butter and pizza dough here, as well as orange marmalade and apple pie. Full-bodied, ripe and fleshy with lots of flavor and depth and a whisker of fruitiness — or is it sweetness? — on the finish. Drink now.
